







Pre-Drill Mounting Holes and Insert Bolts


- Center bracket around the projector and mark mounting holes centered along each slot as shown.
- Lower ceiling bracket and predrill holes:
 - If holes align with a joist, drill 5/32" pilot hole for the 1/4" lag bolts.
 - Where no joist, drill 5/8" hole for toggle bolts.
- Assemble toggle bolt by adding washer and butterfly nut to bolt. Insert through holes, butterfly nut will fold closed inside hole and then spring open once completely through.
- Partially start lag bolts (if any).






Moving to prepare ProjectorShield™

Bolts can be left hanging for now. Next steps will prepare the ProjectorShield™ for mounting.




Attach Side Plates to Top Plate

 Press Side Plate onto Top Plate hooks facing forward. Smooth surface of side plate faces inside.




2. Push Side Plate backwards until hooks lock into place. *Some light* force may be needed to lock plates into place.




Attach Side Plates to Top Plate

Repeat the previous step and attach Side Plates to both sides




Secure safety straps to Top and Side Plates

Zipping safety straps are used as an extra level of protection to keep the ProjectorShield^{TM} held together in case of a catastrophic damaging event.




Attach Bottom Plate

4. Flip unit over and push bottom plate onto hooks facing up




5. Push bottom plate forward and lock into place with hooks. *Some light* force may be needed to lock plates into place.



Secure safety straps to Bottom and Side Plates


6. Add 4 x safety straps to left and right side plates and bottom plate. Trim off tails.




Attach Faceplate

7. Turn unit over and carefully attach clear faceplate onto hooks on the front of your ProjectorShield™.


8. Push faceplate down and lock into place with hooks. *Some light* force may be needed to lock plates into place.






Secure Safety Straps to Faceplate and Side Plates


9. Add 4 x safety straps to Faceplate and Sides. Trim off tails.



Hang ProjectorShield™


- 10. Lift partially built ProjectorShield™ up around projector and feed the pre-hung bolts through passthrough holes in Ceiling Bracket.
- 11. Slide ProjectorShield™ backwards, bringing faceplate close to lens of projector. Tighten bolts and secure ProjectorShield™ to ceiling.






Adjust Projector inside Projector Shield

12. Through the open back of the ProjectorShield™, plug in power and video cables and adjust your projector image to fit to your screen. Be sure to thoroughly secure your projector in place.




Attach Back Plate

13. Press back plate onto back hooks.



14. Push back plate up and lock into place with hooks. *Some light* force may be needed to lock plates into place.



Secure safety straps to Back Plate and Side Plates

15. Add 4 x safety straps to back plate on left and right sides











Prepare SkyRailPlus™ (for previous SkyRailPlus™ owners ONLY)

1. Remove previously installed knobs from sliding plate assembly




2. Remove top plate. This will not be needed with the ProjectorShield™.



Attach Side Plates to Top Plate

3. Insert hooks into Side Plate with hooks facing forward.



4. Push Side Plate backwards until hooks lock into place. *Some light* force may be needed to lock plates into place.



Repeat and attach Side Plates to both sides

Secure safety straps to Top and Side Plates


Zipping safety straps are used as an extra level of protection to keep the ProjectorShield^{TM} held together in case of a catastrophic damaging event.

5. Add 4 x safety straps to left and right side plates. Trim off tails.




Attach Bottom Plate

6. Attach Bottom Plate to hooks on bottom of Side Plates.




7. Push Bottom Plate backwards until hooks lock into place. *Some light* force may be needed to lock plate into place.



Secure safety straps to Bottom and Side Plates


8. Add 4 x safety straps to left and right side plates and bottom plate. Trim off tails.



Mount Partial ProjectorShield™ Enclosure to SkyRailPlus™


9. Before attaching clear faceplate or backplate, bring the partially built ProjectorShield™ Enclosure over and around the projector.

Center the ProjectorShield™ Enclosure on projector using the different slots in Top Plate.












Mount Partial ProjectorShield™ Enclosure to SkyRailPlus™


10. After centering the ProjectorShield™ on the projector, insert the 2x included ¼-20 Hex Nuts into the closest slots in Top Plate.



11. Thread knobs through the projector sliding tray into the 1/4-20 Hex Nuts.

DO NOT OVER TIGHTEN.


Knobs should allow unit to slide forwards and backwards with some resistance.




Attach Clear Faceplate

12. Carefully attach the clear faceplate onto hooks on the front of your ProjectorShield™.

Push faceplate down and lock into place with hooks. *Some light* force may be needed to lock plates into place.




13. Add 4 x safety straps to Faceplate and Sides. Trim off tails.




Adjust Projector

14. **Adjust** projector position for the best image fit for your enclosure.


Next using the slots in the Top Plate, side the ProjectorShield[™] as close as possible to the lens of the projector.






Attach Back Plate

15. Press back plate onto back hooks, push up and lock into place. **Some light** force may be needed to lock plates into hooks.



16. Add 4 x safety straps to back plate and Sides. Trim off tails.
