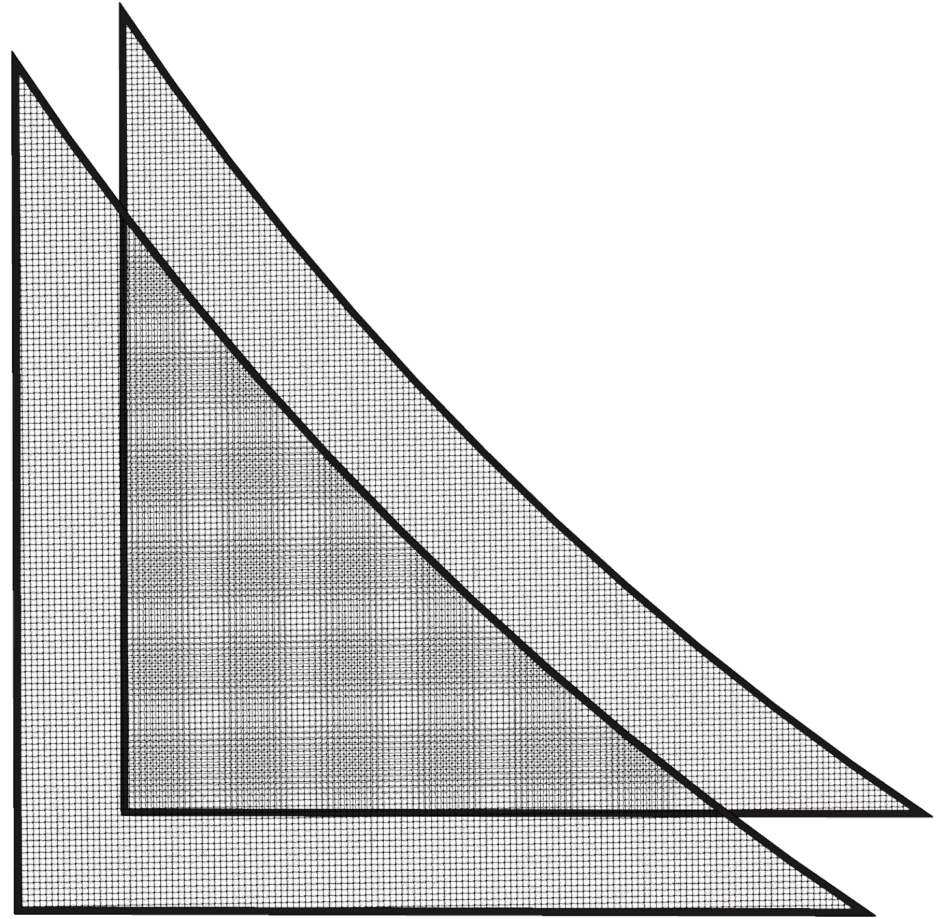
Angled Netting™ Parts List

Netting:

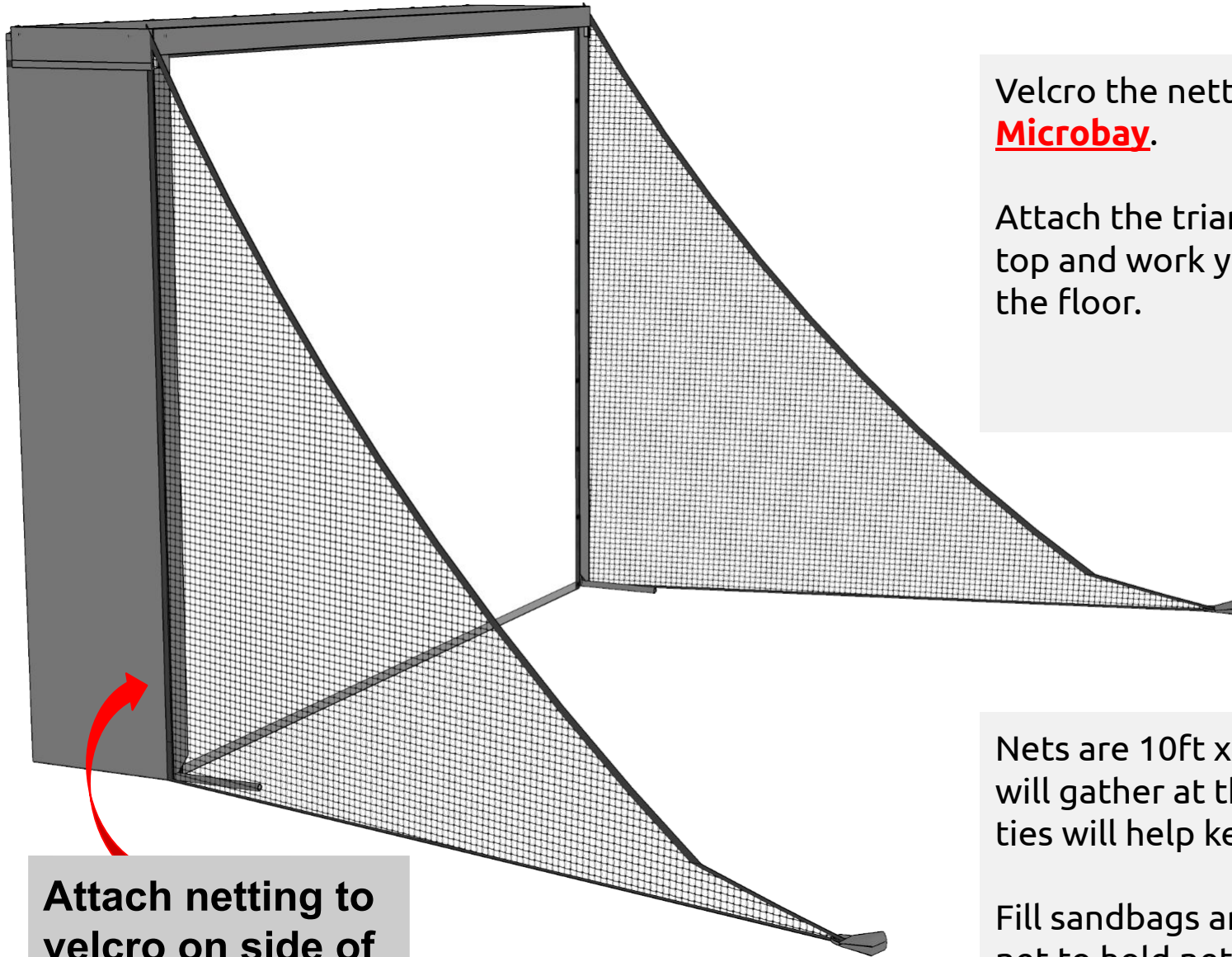
- 2 x Angled Netting panels

Other:

- 2 x sandbags (sand not included)



Install Side Nets, **MicroBay**



Attach netting to velcro on side of **MicroBay**

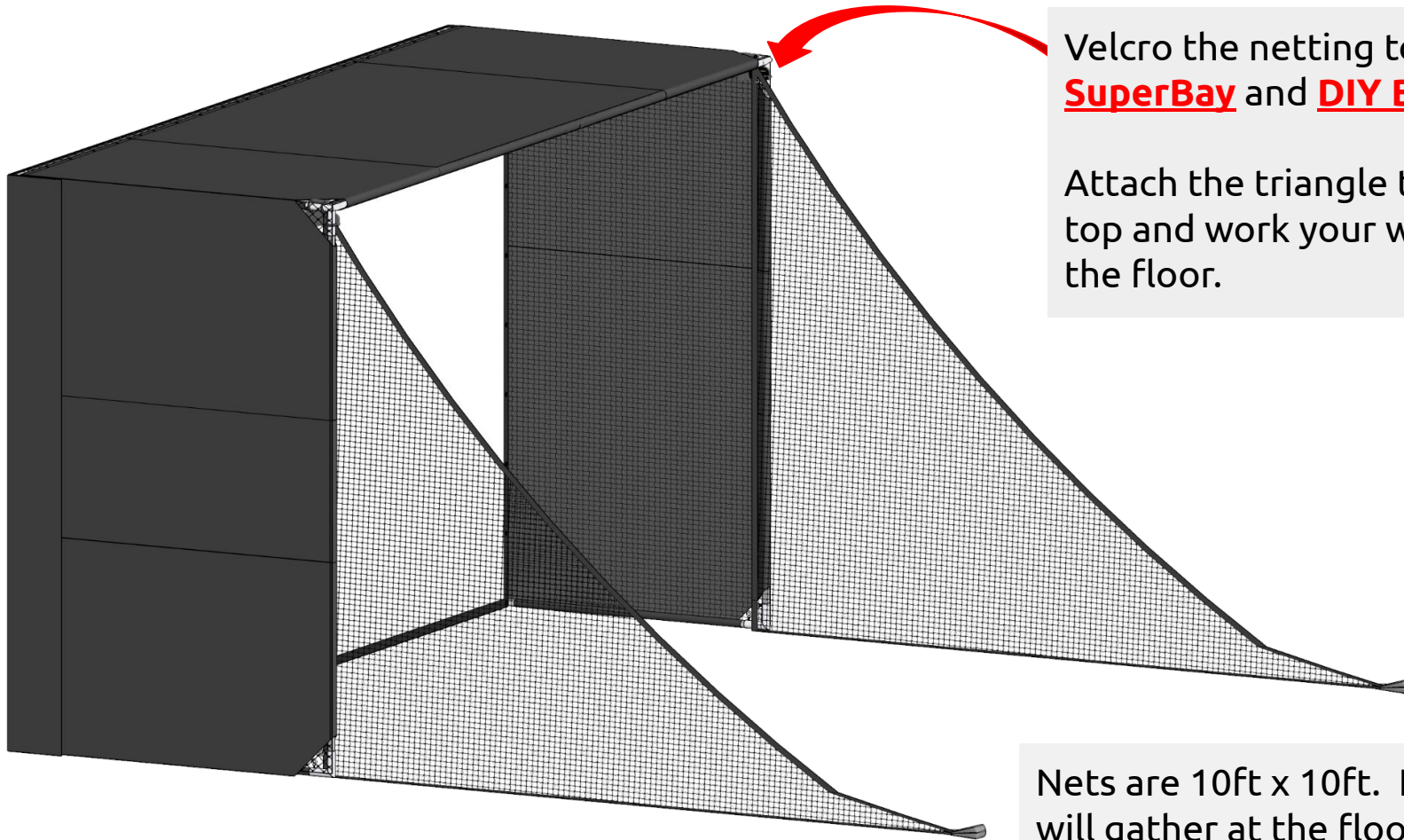
Velcro the netting to side of **MicroBay**.

Attach the triangle tip of net at the top and work your way down to the floor.

Nets are 10ft x 10ft. Extra netting will gather at the floor. A few zip ties will help keep netting neat.

Fill sandbags and install at end of net to hold netting in place.

Install Side Nets, **SuperBay** and **DIY Bay**



Velcro the netting to inside of the **SuperBay** and **DIY Bay**.

Attach the triangle tip of net at the top and work your way down to the floor.

Nets are 10ft x 10ft. Extra netting will gather at the floor. A few zip ties will help keep netting neat.

Fill sandbags and install at end of net to hold netting in place.
